This role will provide valuable experience in many aspects of translation & editorial work. You'll play a key role in our close-knit team, and work with us to spread the message about EMERGENCY's work across the UK.

Flexibility and an ability to multitask are essential.

Essential Requirements:

- Native speaker level of English
- Graduate or student of English, Modern Languages, Translation Studies or other relevant disciplines
- Excellent degree of literacy; excellent written communication skills
- An interest in translation and languages
- Close attention to detail

Desirable Requirements:

- Interest in humanitarian work
- A good understanding of Italian

The internship is unpaid but lunch and reasonable travel expenses will be refunded.

Ideally, we would like you to volunteer with us for at least 2 days a week, but we can be flexible with this for the right candidate.

The EMERGENCY UK offices are based in London. The candidate can either work from the office or remotely.

The internship lasts for 3 months, starting in December 2018.

We cannot sponsor visas, so only applicants who have eligibility to work in the UK will be considered for the above post.
